Ernest Miller _____ was born on July 21, 1899, in Oak Park, Illinois, a suburb of Chicago. During World War I he was an ambulance driver in Italy, and as a reporter he covered the Spanish Civil War. During World War II he was present at D-Day and the liberation of Paris. Famous writings include 'A Farewell to Arms', 'For Whom the Bell Tolls', and 'The Old Man and the Sea'. He lived by his favourite expression 'first one must endure', earning the distinction of being called timeless. He committed suicide in 1961.
